in partnership with the University Hospital Southampton NHS Foundation

Trust. The programme facilitates direct observation and reflection on the practice of major trauma care. One must have a Bachelor's degree in a relevant subject with a 2:2 or above grade/GPA. She/he must be a registered health professional working with a trauma setting. Applications from mature applicants who meet the criteria for admission are also welcomed. Applicants must have an overall Ielts score of 6.5 along with a reading, writing, speaking and listening score of six. One can apply for the Southampton International Merit Scholarship of up to £5,000. Last date to apply is 31 July.
